

Doctoral Admission, Program, and Graduation Requirements

5. Computer Utilization (demonstration of competence);
6. Dissertation (12 to 20 credits);
7. Internship (6 credits);
8. Leadership training seminars (6 credits);
9. The student must maintain continuous enrollment and demonstrate progress toward the degree, including documentation of leadership accomplishments in a doctoral portfolio;
10. The student must have completed two consecutive semesters of full-time graduate study and residency requirements;
11. The student must have a successful defense of the dissertation;
12. The student must be recommended by the faculty of the department and the College for the degree;
13. The student must complete a minimum of 75 credits beyond the bachelor's degree. This includes the 72-credit minimum to satisfy department degree requirements.

Graduation Requirements for Doctorate (PhD) in Special Education

Students must apply for graduation early in the semester in which they plan to graduate. All dissertation and application paperwork must be
