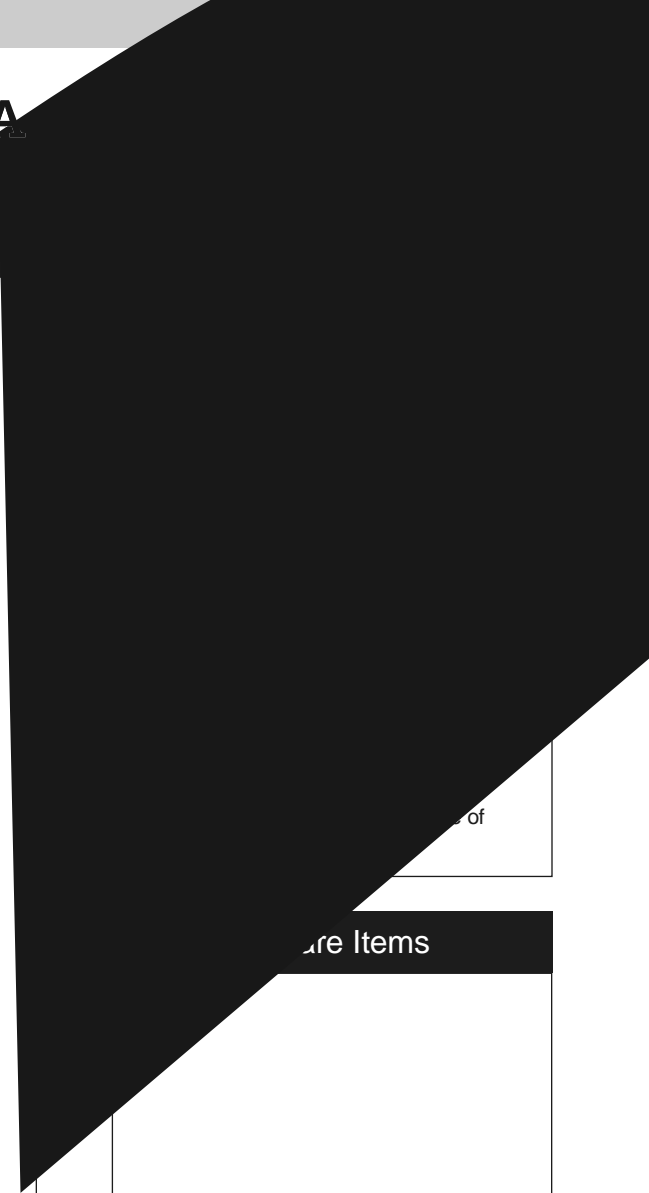
- %o Sterile gauze pads
