I. Background

The GraduateCollege GovernanceDocumenthas been recently approved by the University GraduateFaculty and the University Faculty Senaten accordance with the Graduate College GovernanceDocument, each College is required to developits own detailed guidelines and criteria for themembership in the graduate faculty and submit the University Graduate Council for approval. The aim of this document is to establishe implementation of the Graduate College Document in the College of Engineering appropriate Science

II. General

Members of the Graduate Faculty in the College of Engineering and Computer Screeappointed according to the Graduate College Governance Document Each department within the College may establish additional criteria for the graduate faculty subject to the College University approval process. Membership in the Graduate Faculty for a five-year termand is renewable, subject to review in accordance with the Graduate College Governance Document the following guideline.

Four levels of graduate facultys defined by the Graduate Governance document are as follow:

- 1. <u>Graduate Facultymay</u> teach garduate courses, serve on and chair Masters and Phasters and Phasters and Serve on committees that oversee graduate programs.
- 2. <u>Associate Graduate Facultry</u>ay teach graduate courses and serve on Master's committees Any graduate program may have additionaltteri criteriaauthorizingAssociate Graduate FaculFhyacC50

- 3. New FAU hires as tenured or tenure track faculty shall be approved the Graduate College Governance Docume by the College Dear and recommended to the Graduate College Dear for Graduate Faculty approximent.
- 4. Current FAU employees ho are not presently graduate faculty may send a Graduate Faculty Status Application Form 1 (available on the Graduate College website), a CV, and a nominating letter (e.g.from their unit head, such as an HBOI Dicerto the Department Chair. Their appointment to Graduate Faculty, Associate Graduate Faculty, or Graduate Lecturer shall be conducted according to this guideline. Upon the Desarp's soval, the completed From 1 will be setto the Graduate College any who then sends the letter granting the appropriate graduate faculty status.
- 5. Re-appointments will be every 5 years for Graduate Faculty, Associate Graduate Faculty, and Graduate Faculty Emeriti, and every year for Graduate Lecturers.
- 6. For reappointments, the candidate faculty member will reviewed by the Department Graduate Committee, which will convey its recommendation to the Department Chair. The Chair will then forward his/her recommendations to the College Graduate Committee. Upon reviewing therecommendations of the College Graduate Committee, the Dean will send his/her recommendations to the Dean of the Graduate Collegeappointment.

IV. Graduate Faculty

Eligibility for the membership in the Graduate Faculty shall be based on the based

- Active involvement in research activities as evidenced by:
 - (a) An excellent publication record in pereviewed journals, refereed conferences, scholarly books, and granted patents
 - (b) Sponsored research support
 - (c) Editorial activities and memberips/participations in professional societies
- Teaching of graduate courses over the past five years
- Chairing Master's thesisth.D. dissertation to completion over the past five years
- Serving on thesis/dissertation supervisory committees as a membere pasfive years

The candidate faculty memberill be reviewed by the Department Graduate Committee, which will make a recommendation to the Department Chair. The Chair will then forward his/her recommendations to the College Graduate Committee. Lepuiewing the recommendations of the College Graduate Committee, the Dean will send his/her recommendations to the Dean of the Graduate College for repopointment.

V. Associate Graduate Faculty

Associate Graduateaculty shallmeet the following University minimum requirements:
